



Purchase photographic images for private use

We have tried to make ordering photographs of the Museum's collection as simple as possible.

If you are interested in purchasing photographs for your private research we will send you a Photograph Sales Order Form. (If you subsequently use the photographs in a commercial publication [book, magazine, television program or similar] contact us and we will send you a Reproduction Rights Application Form.)

When you complete a Photograph Enquiry Form we will check that the item is part of our collection, is able to be photographed (some items undergo lengthy Conservation or are on display) and that the Museum has the legal right to offer the item (Copyright). There is no obligation to purchase any of the photographs we offer.

The Photograph Sales Order Form has details of print sizes, from A5 up to A2, and prices for colour or black and white prints. If there are any questions regarding your order, and there often are, there are two numbers you can call, the main Museum

switchboard number 020 77300717 followed by either extension number 2476 or 2495.

We aim to complete all orders we receive within 30 working days of receiving your payment. You can check the progress of your order, or even cancel, at any point and your money will be refunded.
