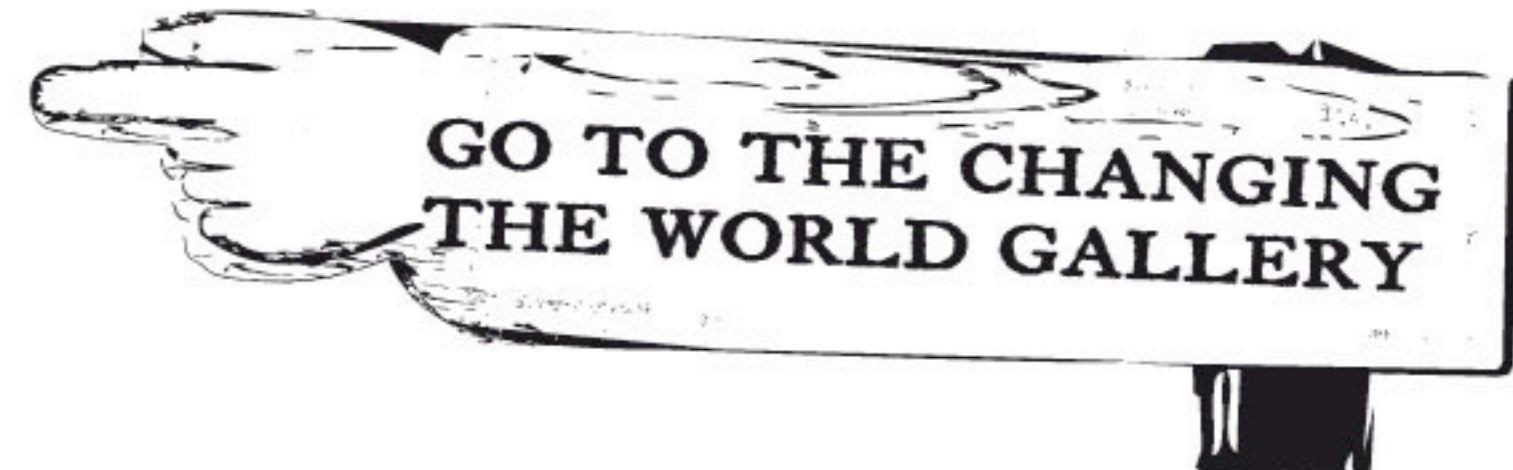


Mary and Florence in the Crimea

2. Where did Mary come from? _____

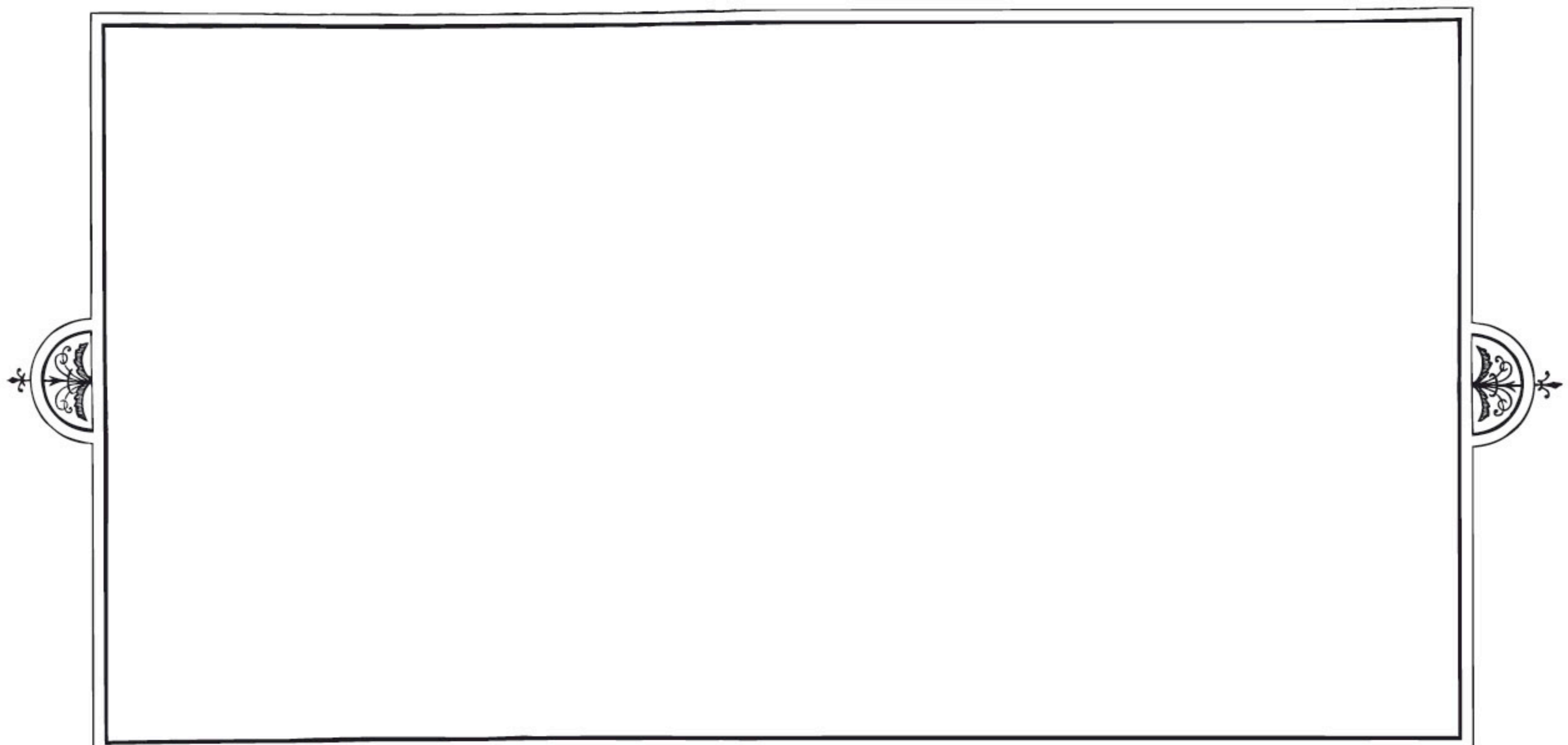

6. **Find** my pet in the next case. What is his name?

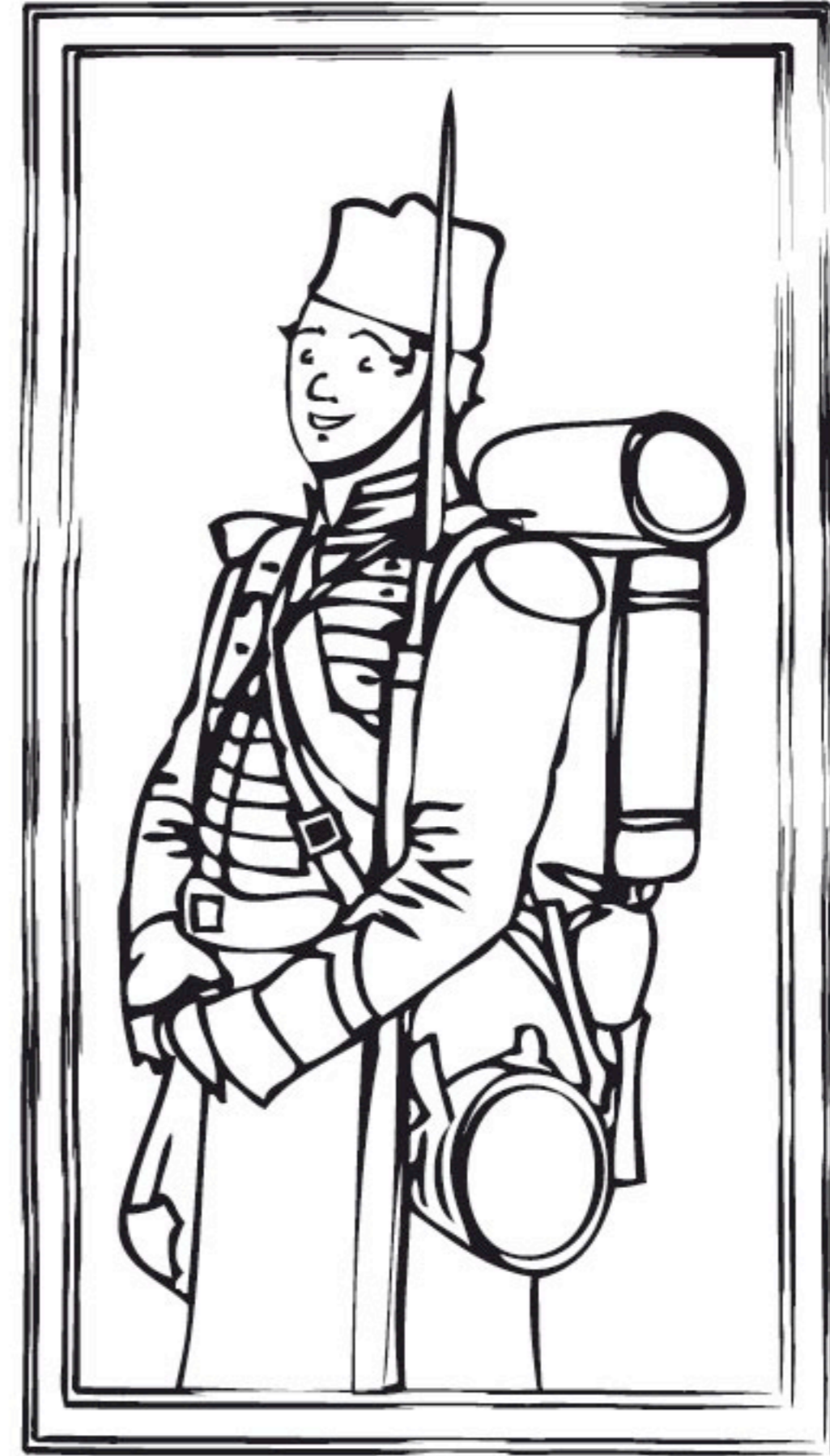
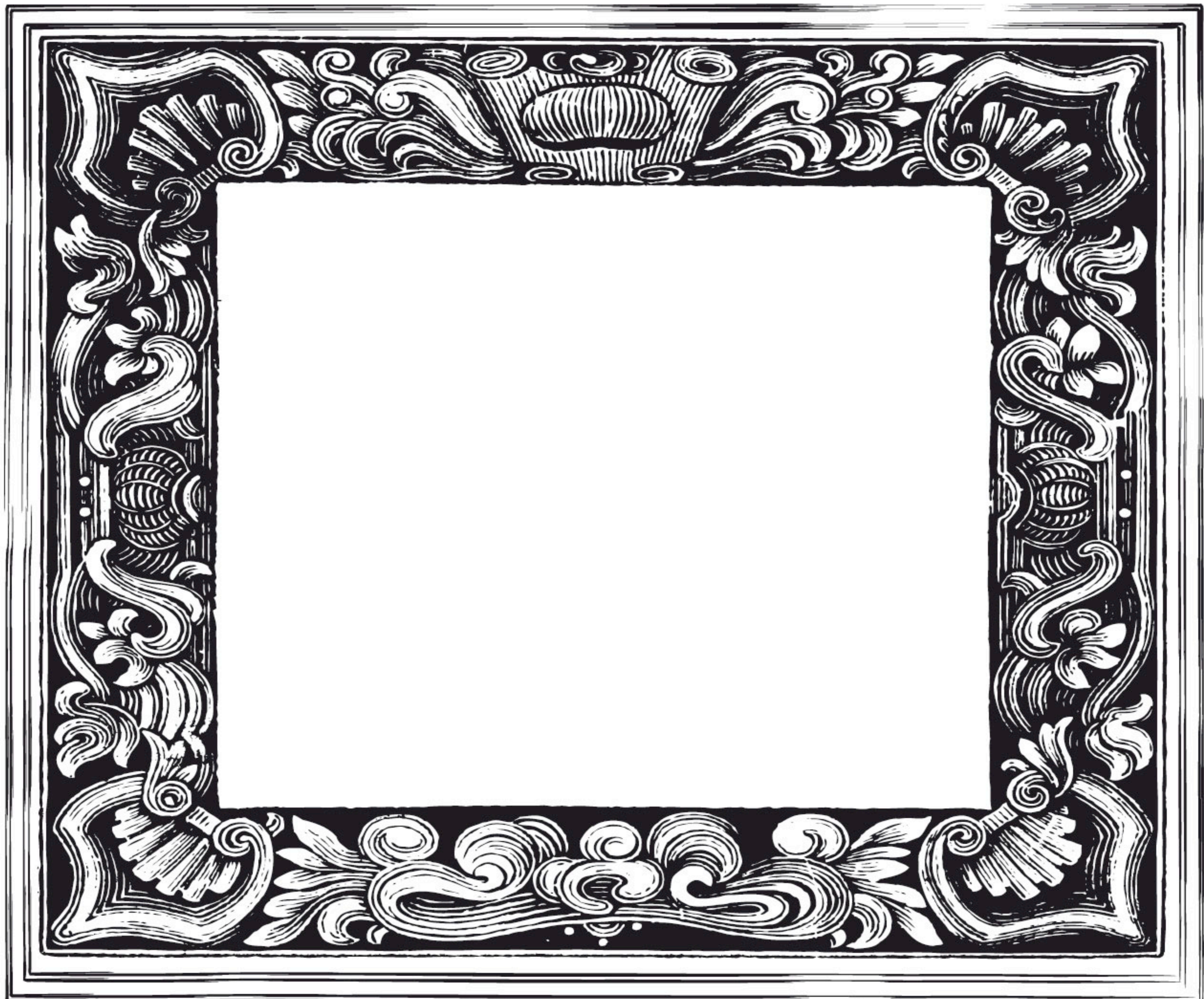
