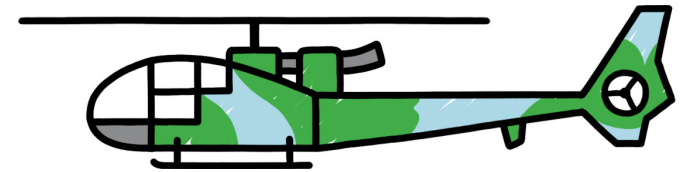
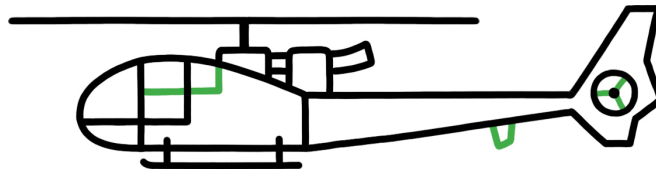
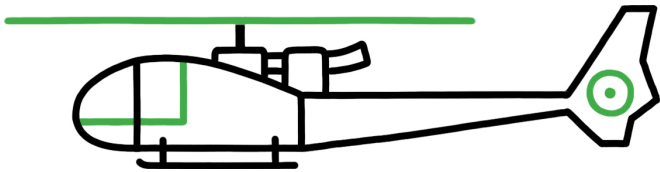
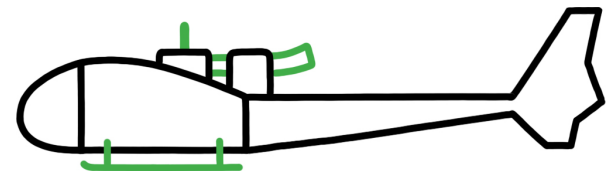
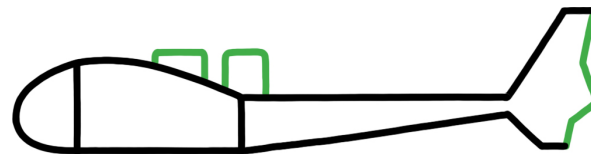
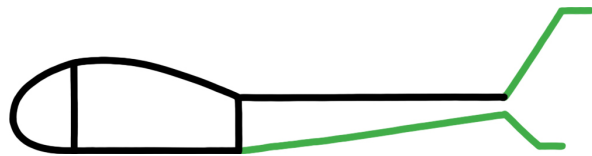
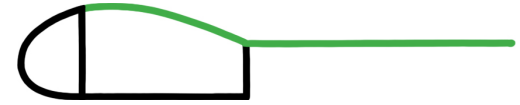
This is a Cromwell Tank from the Second World War.
