

not be returned home to be buried. This caused
great sadness for families and the general public.





# A Warrior Buried in Westminster: What's the Story?

The extraordinary tale of the unknown warrior buried today in Westminster Abbey

The Great War resulted in the deaths of
hundreds of thousands of British soldiers,
many of whom were never, leaving
families and the nation stricken by grief. The
idea for the Unknown Warrior was brought
to life by (an army Chaplain) and

minister David Lloyd George to bury one of the
unidentified servicemen who had died on the
Western Front to all those who had
died in action, especially the
The selection process took place in secret.
