

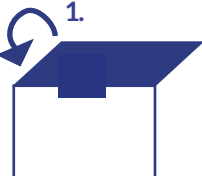
Florence and Mary Scavenger Hunt

The Crimea can get very cold; shall we find something that would keep you warm?



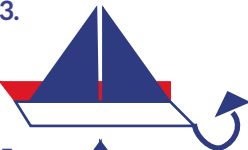
2. Journey
