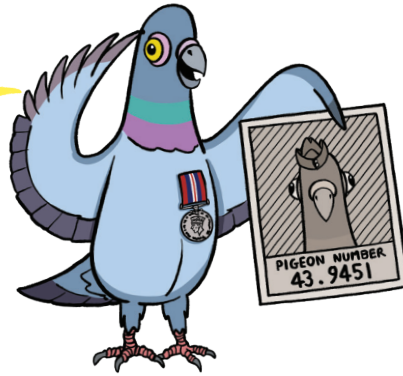


DECODE AND DISCOVER TRAIL

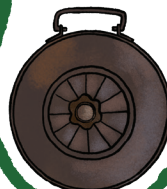

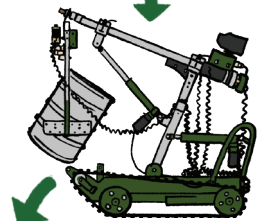
